Melvin's professional and advocacy journey includes service as President of SPEAKOUT, Virginia's statewide youth advisory board, and roles as a Youth Support Partner at UMFS, Marketing Intern with American Express, and an All-Star Intern with FosterClub, where he contributed to national conversations on foster care reform. He has worked alongside influential leaders, including staff in the Office of Vice President Kamala Harris, and authored a federal policy report through the Congressional Coalition on Adoption Institute, which he presented at The White House and to Members of Congress and federal agencies.

Currently, Melvin serves as the Independent Living Coordinator at The Friends of Foster Care, where he supports young adults as they navigate the transition to adulthood. He also serves as an Advisory Board Member for the organization. His governance experience includes having served on the Board of Directors for UMFS and the Old Dominion University Alumni Association, where he advocated for youth-centered leadership and inclusive policy.
